National Senior Tournament – Trial Rules

Hockey New Zealand will be trialing the following rules at the 2011 National Senior Tournament:

- Player Eligibility – players can choose to represent their Province of Origin or current Association
- Green Cards are an automatic two minute suspension
- Penalty Corners – if a player breaks they get sent to halfway.
- Penalty Shoot-outs – all drawn games will result in a Penalty Shoot-out
