## Executive Summary

The purpose of this review was “To create a national competition calendar that enables hockey players access to national, regional and local levels of competition and recognizes that Hockey is a year round sport.”

The committee was asked to produce two specific outputs from this review:

**1. Recommended Calendar of National Domestic Tournaments**

Suggested timing for all National Domestic Tournaments administered by Hockey New Zealand.

**2. Recommendations on Tournament Formats**

Suggested formats, including draw, length, maximum number of teams, for all National Domestic Tournaments managed by Hockey New Zealand.



Hockey New Zealand believes that the calendar and formats that we have recommended are what is best for hockey in New Zealand based on the following four key considerations:

1. Pathway – clearly defined pathway for our athletes that gains the maximum for our National sides
2. Timing of the NHL and winter congestion
3. Competition Standards – a sound Domestic Calendar enhances the quality of competition
4. Reduction of Barriers – the barriers to competition are reduced and the retention of athletes to Hockey is paramount
5. Cost – cost to the sport (HNZ and Associations), players, officials, and parents

## NATIONAL DOMESTIC TOURNAMENT REVIEW OUTCOMES

What has been put forward is a national calendar which takes into account all of the above considerations and will encourage regional competitions at all levels.

It was agreed that no major change to our domestic tournament programme was required, but the shift in High Performance focus on Under 18 and the above needed to be taken into consideration.

There was consensus that tournaments needed to take into account the following:

- Venues
- Timing and length
- Number of teams

The process from here will be in two stages.

In 2012 the new calendar will come into effect with regards to:

- The timings of the tournaments (Under 15s moving to October, Under 21s no earlier than May 1<sup>st</sup>)
- The change of the Under 15s to 16 teams
- The change in tournament format to Hatch, Collier, National Senior and Under 15s
- Under 21s moving to 8 teams
- Introducing a rule that allows players to choose only two national tournaments to compete in.

In 2013 the new calendar will come into effect with regards to:

- Under 18s becoming an 8 team competition with the 8 regional teams competing at the National Tournament
- A second tier Under 18 competition being in place for Associations to participate in

## b) Tournament Recommendations

### Hatch and Collier

#### Summary

Overall it was agreed that the Hatch and Collier tournaments should remain largely unchanged, however there was concern over the current iconic status these tournaments have, and the great emphasis that is put on winning these tournaments.

#### Action 1

That the Hatch and Collier Tournaments should remain as they are in terms of timing, and number of teams.

#### Action 2

That the Hatch and Collier Tournaments are reduced to 6 days and maximum of 8 games.

#### Action 3

That Hockey New Zealand takes an educational approach with Parents, Participants, Coaches and Volunteers that the emphasis for Hatch and Collier Tournaments should be on participation and is the entry level for representative hockey.

Benefits for Hockey:

- Reduction in costs for participants, parents and associations
- Competition based at appropriate level for participants
- Tournaments remain important to hockey in New Zealand



## Under 15

### Summary

The Under 15s tournaments will undergo slight changes in that they will be played in October from 2012, be reduced to 16 teams and will incorporate a challenge system for teams moving between Premier and Championships level

### Action 1

That the National Under 15 Premier and Championship Tournaments will be reduced to 16 teams from 2012

### Action 2

That from 2012 the National Under 15 Tournaments will be shifted to the first week of the October school holidays

### Action 3

That Hockey New Zealand introduces a challenge system in the year of the tournament for teams who wish to move from Championship to Premier Tournaments.

### Rules of the Challenge System:

- Teams who placed 14th, 15th, or 16th in the previous year's National Under 15 Premier Tournament will be open to challenge from teams from the previous year's National Under 15 Championship Tournament as per the below rules:
- The highest ranked Association 'A' team from the Championship tournament can challenge
  - Firstly within their geographical region
    - I. Upper North Island - Auckland, Bay of Plenty, Counties Manukau, Northland, North Harbour, Tauranga, Thames Valley, Waikato
    - II. Lower North Island - Central Hawke's Bay, Hawke's Bay, Horowhenua, Manawatu, Poverty Bay, Rangitikei, Ruahine-Dannevirke, Taranaki, Wairarapa, Wanganui, Wellington
    - III. South Island - Buller, Canterbury, Central Otago, Eastern Southland, Invercargill, Malvern, Marlborough, Mid Canterbury, Nelson, North Otago, Otago, South Canterbury, West CoastIf no teams within their geographical region, they can challenge 14, 15, or 16 at their cost
- If the highest ranked Association 'A' team does not challenge, then the 2nd highest ranked Association 'A' team can challenge following above criteria.
- If the 2nd highest ranked Association 'A' team does not challenge, then the 3rd highest ranked Association 'A' team can challenge following above criteria.
- Any challenge is at the challengers cost and must be done before a date mutually agreed upon by Associations and Hockey New Zealand.

In 2012, the teams eligible to challenge will be the 17th, 18th, 19th and 20th teams from the Premier Tournament in 2011. For example:

2011 rankings (based on 2010)  
13th = Otago (safe)  
14th = Thames Valley  
15th = Nelson  
16th = South Canterbury

Associations available to challenge:

1st = Taranaki (17th) - must notify intent to challenge/ not challenge by x date  
2nd = Horowhenua (18th) – must notify intent to challenge/not challenge by x date  
3rd = Central Otago (19th) – must notify intent to challenge/not challenge by x date

HNZ will hold accommodation for the challenging and challenged teams at the Premier and Championship venues.

### Benefits for Hockey:

- Cleaner and more manageable draw and evenness of competition for all participants
- Challenge system offers opportunity for Associations who may have been relegated previously, but have a stronger line up in the year of the competition
- Movement of tournaments to October removes the congestion from July

## Under 18

### **Summary**

It was agreed that the High Performance programme would commence at the U18 Tournament and therefore this event would move to an 8 team regionally based competition to allow the best players from around the country to play against each other in a high quality elite tournament. There was concern that the Regional structure would not be in place in time for a Regional tournament to take place in 2012 and so it was decided to recommend that the transition take place in 2013.

### **Action 1**

That from 2012 the National Under 18 Tournament will remain in the first week of the July school holidays

### **Action 2**

That from 2013 the National U18 Tournament will be open to Regional teams only. The National U18 Tournament is part of the High Performance Pathway and national selections will be identified at the Under 18 National tournament from the regional teams.

It was agreed that the National U18 Tournament moving to Regional Teams only in 2013 is based on the fact that Hockey New Zealand will work with each of the regions to develop their regional structures to ensure that quality regional tournaments, selection processes and Regional talent programmes are in place.



### **Action 3**

That from 2013 the second division tournament at Under 18 level will be open to any Association A or B team that wish to enter

### **Benefits for Hockey:**

- Lift the standard of the Under 18 tournament
- Greater emphasis on Regional Talent Programmes to identify the elite U18 players within their region
- Opportunity for developing players to still attend a national tournament at this age group
- Strengthen the Regional Tournament delivery structure

## Under 21

### Summary

It was agreed that the Under 21 Tournament should be aligned with the same teams as at NHL, however noted that there may be some assistance required for the existing NHL regions to field the respective teams.

Overall the tournament remains unchanged with the timing of the tournament and the format the key discussion points.

### Action 1

That from 2012 the National Under 21 Tournament will start no earlier than the 1<sup>st</sup> May to allow sufficient build up time, however the timing should not clash with university exams, and where possible be located in the University holidays.

### Action 2

That from 2012 the National Under 21 Tournament will consist of the same Regions that contest the National Hockey League

### Action 3

That from 2012 the National Under 21 Tournament format will be two pools of four followed by playoff rounds with a total of 6 games over 6 days.

### Benefits for Hockey:

- Clear pathway in the Regions from Under 18 through to NHL level
- Reduction of cost to players and Regions



## Senior

### **Summary**

It was agreed that the National Senior tournament is an important part of the domestic tournament programme. It allows players from smaller Associations who may not have aspirations to play NHL a chance to continue to play representative hockey as well as provides an opportunity for development for players from larger Associations.

However it was also identified that the venue for this tournament has a direct impact on the number of entries and so this should be taken into account when making tournament allocations.

Overall the tournament remains largely the same with only one action with regard to timing.



### **Action 1**

That from 2012 the timing of the Senior tournament will not be held in the October school holidays however it will be held in the September/October timeframe. The exact timing each year will be dependent on university exams and the finish date of the winter hockey season.

### **Benefits to Hockey:**

- Reducing the congestion in the October school holidays
- Reduction of cost as not in peak travel times
- Greater emphasis on the tournament as a development tournament for NHL players plus representative tournament for senior players.

## National Hockey League

### **Summary**

There were no recommendations for the National Hockey League as it was not a part of the brief, however it was felt that it is important that the timing of the National Hockey League should remain locked in the July/August timeframe for at least three years as the overall calendar that has been recommended has been based on the current NHL time frame.

## Masters

### **Summary**

The committee did not put forward any recommendations for the National Masters Tournament however identified that the Masters Council may have to look at the number of divisions and the size of the tournament in future, if they do not want to further limit the number of Associations able to host the tournament.

## i. General Recommendations

During the course of the review it has been identified that various aspects that closely affect the Domestic Tournament Programme were not included in the scope of the review. The following recommendations have been put forward as a result

### Regional Structure

That the Regional Structure and the Regions that Associations affiliate to needs to be reviewed as there are concerns that some 'Regions' do not have the player base to be able to support a full high performance development programme from Under 18 through to NHL.

### Tournament Allocation Guidelines

That when allocating tournaments serious consideration needs to be given to the following factors:

- Cost
- Facilities
- Travel time (one flight plus drive for High Performance Tournaments)

It was agreed that the minimum specifications to host for each tournament be published so that Associations know what they are capable of hosting.

It was also agreed that between Hockey New Zealand and each Association an assessment/update of the facilities should be done to identify which Tier each association is capable of hosting.

It was recommend that allocations should be made four years in advance, so that Associations can plan ahead both in terms of arrangements for teams, and in terms of hosting opportunities.

### Regional Competitions

It was agreed that it should not be up to the committee to decide what Regional events take place, however they recommended that Associations work with their Regions to set up their own Regional tournaments especially at Under 18 level where they could be used as a selection process for the Regional Under 18 teams.

### Player Welfare

The Hockey New Zealand Board has adopted a new player welfare ruling with respect to the number of national tournaments a player can compete in. The rationale for this ruling is to:

- Minimise the risks of player burnout and injury
- Reduce the costs borne by players and parents by participating in multiple tournaments
- Create more selection opportunities for more players
- The introduction of U18 and U21 national programmes

It was also agreed that this should be supported with education disseminated by Hockey New Zealand for delivery by the regions to all - players, parents, coaches and associations.

The ruling agreed will read:

***Any tournaments or matches conducted must be properly regulated to ensure that the health and welfare of young players is considered at all times. In this respect a player can choose to play in only two National Tournaments conducted by Hockey New Zealand in a calendar year. The list of National Tournaments is as below:***

- ***NHL***
- ***National Senior Tournament***
- ***Under 21***
- ***Under 18 National Tournament***
- ***Under 18 Open Tournament***
- ***Under 15 Premier Tournament***
- ***Under 15 Championship Tournament***
- ***Hatch Cup***
- ***Collier Trophy***
